Dear Ted:

Our last survey involving the above captioned loss location discloses the damaging ground movement from confirmed mine subsidence has ceased. As a result of this recent information, the reported date of this occurrence is now over. The completion of permanent repairs would now be in order.

The Fund reminds the policyholder of their option to reinstate the mine subsidence coverage, so that coverage will be effective in the event of a subsequent mine subsidence occurrence. In order for the policyholder to reinstate this coverage, they must contact their agent or insurer presently insuring the property. Additionally, the policyholder must inform the agent or insurer that mine subsidence has ceased and mine subsidence coverage be reinstated. Public Act 098-1007 is attached for your review and use.

The Fund's involvement on this matter is now concluded.
